Welcome to our re-telling of Ruth's story. There's a video lasting about 20 minutes which tells the whole story using places around the Chapel and in the fields nearby and a companion video lasting about 6 minutes with some thoughts and questions for reflection, picking up on some ways in which Ruth's world seems surprisingly familiar.

We think the story is a great story which works well on its own but there is plenty to think about and the companion video may help with that. If you decide to watch it, it's up to you whether you listen to it before or after the story. You may want to watch either of the videos more than once.

There are opportunities to pause in both videos. There are music interludes in the story which mark the ends and beginnings of the four chapters in the Bible. In the companion video, you could pause at the changes between images which mark six themes for reflection:

- What it means to be well fed or hungry
- How it feels to be a migrant
- How we see women
- What part love plays in the story
- How we think about relationships and family
- Where we think God is in all this
